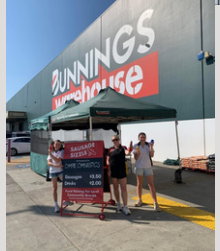

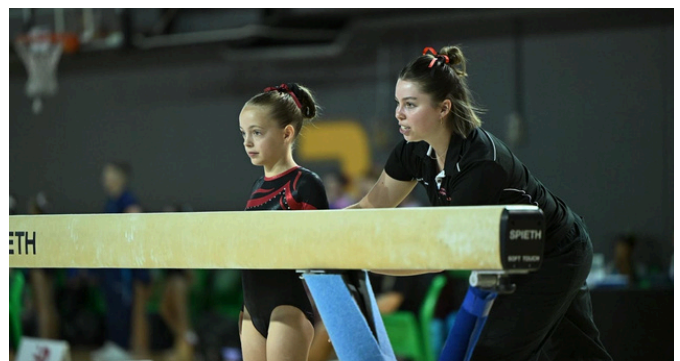
Spotlight - Coach Dannika-Lee

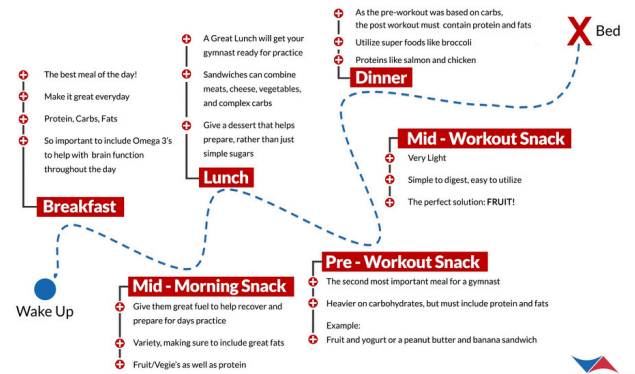
